**Study Leave for Years 11-13:** Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October to Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October only.  
All students must attend all classes on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October & Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> October.

Year 10 Students sitting Level 1 Examinations may have study leave for their Year 11 classes and in the morning for afternoon examinations. Apart from this they must attend their Year 10 classes.

All examination sessions are for 3 hours. All students must remain in the examination for at least the recommended time for the standards they are entered for. Often this will be the full 3 hours. Please note that the afternoon examinations finish at 4pm.  
All examinations will be held in the College Hall (WA1).

Students must ensure they:

- Bring all necessary equipment and stationary to their examinations.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the examination.
- Turn up in plenty of time and on the correct day.
- Wear correct school uniform to the examinations.

Students wishing to sit examinations at an alternative time must apply to the Principal's Nominee, Mrs Shields, prior to September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Permission will only be granted for genuine clashes of events.

Students who are sick or who for other reasons are unable to attend an examination must have a parent contact the College prior to the examination starting. In these cases it will not be possible to sit the examination in another examination time slot.
